PAPER TRAIL - FILM 1

DURATION – 27.53 minutes

LANGUAGE – English

SYNOPSIS:

Charity, a young Nigerian woman, leaves Lagos - Nigeria for Malta after accepting a domestic job that promises a better future for her family. On arrival, her employers confiscate her passport, force her into grueling hours, and pay her below minimum wage, trapping her in abusive modern-day slavery. As her health deteriorates, Charity confides in her friends back home and later meets Linda, a fellow Nigerian who recognizes the situation as illegal. With Linda's help and intervention from anti-trafficking agents, Charity is rescued from the exploitative household. Given safety, support, and a fair chance at work, Charity begins healing and reclaiming hope for a dignified life.





STREET SWEEPER – FILM 2

DURATION – 10.51 minutes

LANGUAGE – English

SYNOPSIS:

Hari, a young Nepali migrant in Malta, works as a street sweeper to support his family, believing he has secured a fair-paying job abroad. He soon discovers the recruitment agency deducts most of his wages and holds him in debt bondage by confiscating his passport. A confrontation with the friend who recruited him reveals the cycle of exploitation, where workers are forced to replace themselves to escape. Trapped, exhausted, and unable to quit, Hari sinks into despair as the agency tightens its control. A chance encounter with a teenage girl helps Hari realize he is a victim of human trafficking and gives him hope of seeking help by speaking out.

MIDDAY SHIFT – FILM 3

DURATION – 13.19 minutes

LANGUAGE – English

SYNOPSIS:

This film depicts the dark world of an upscale escort service, focusing on Mia, a woman forced into sex work through coercion and threats from her boss Bruno. It shows her interactions with clients, her emotional and physical exploitation, and Bruno's controlling behavior, including threatening her with violence. A client witnesses her distress and reports her situation to anti-trafficking authorities. The story highlights the brutality of human trafficking and the importance of reporting such crimes. Overall, it exposes the grim realities faced by victims and the need for intervention.
