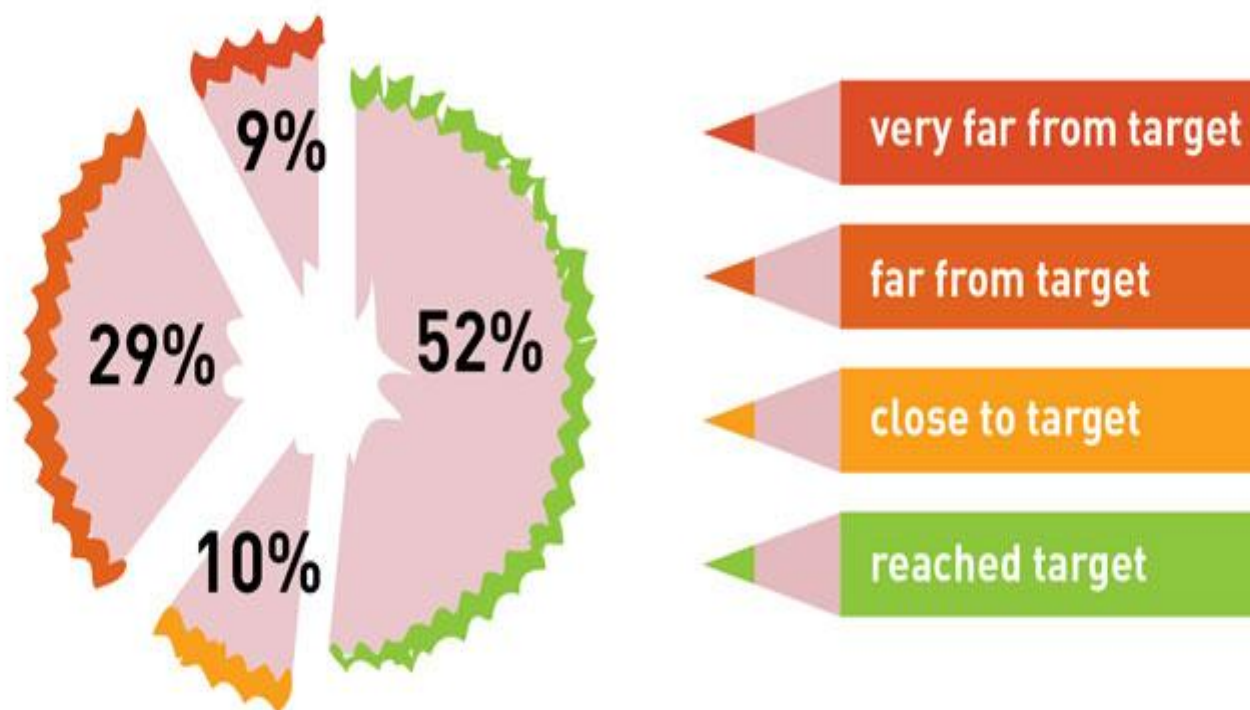

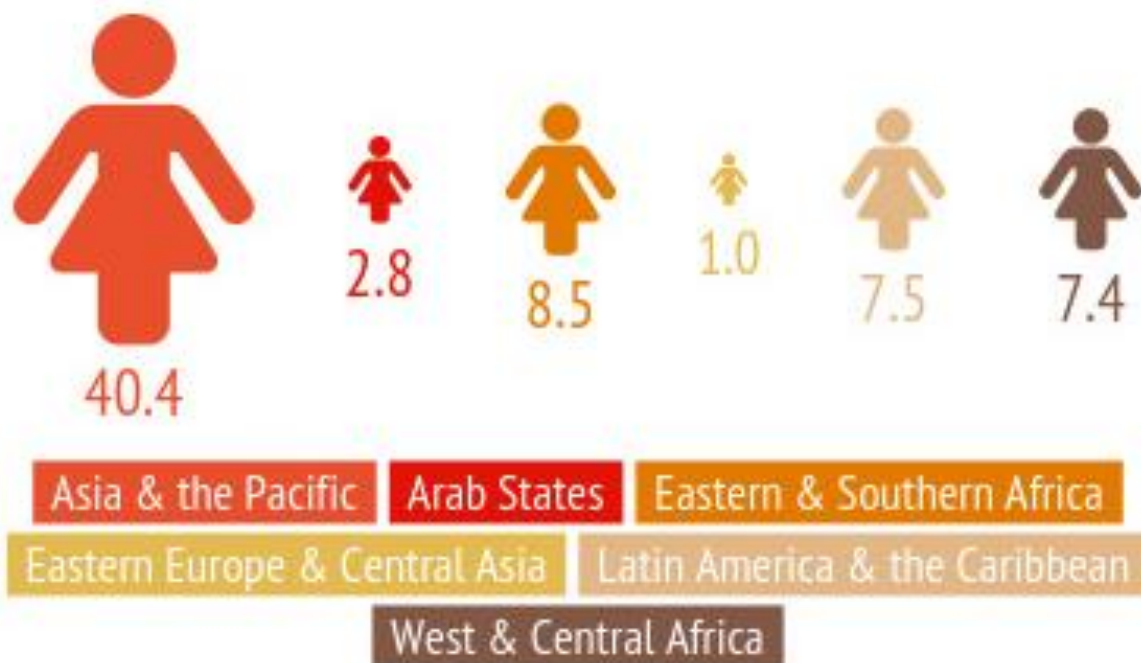

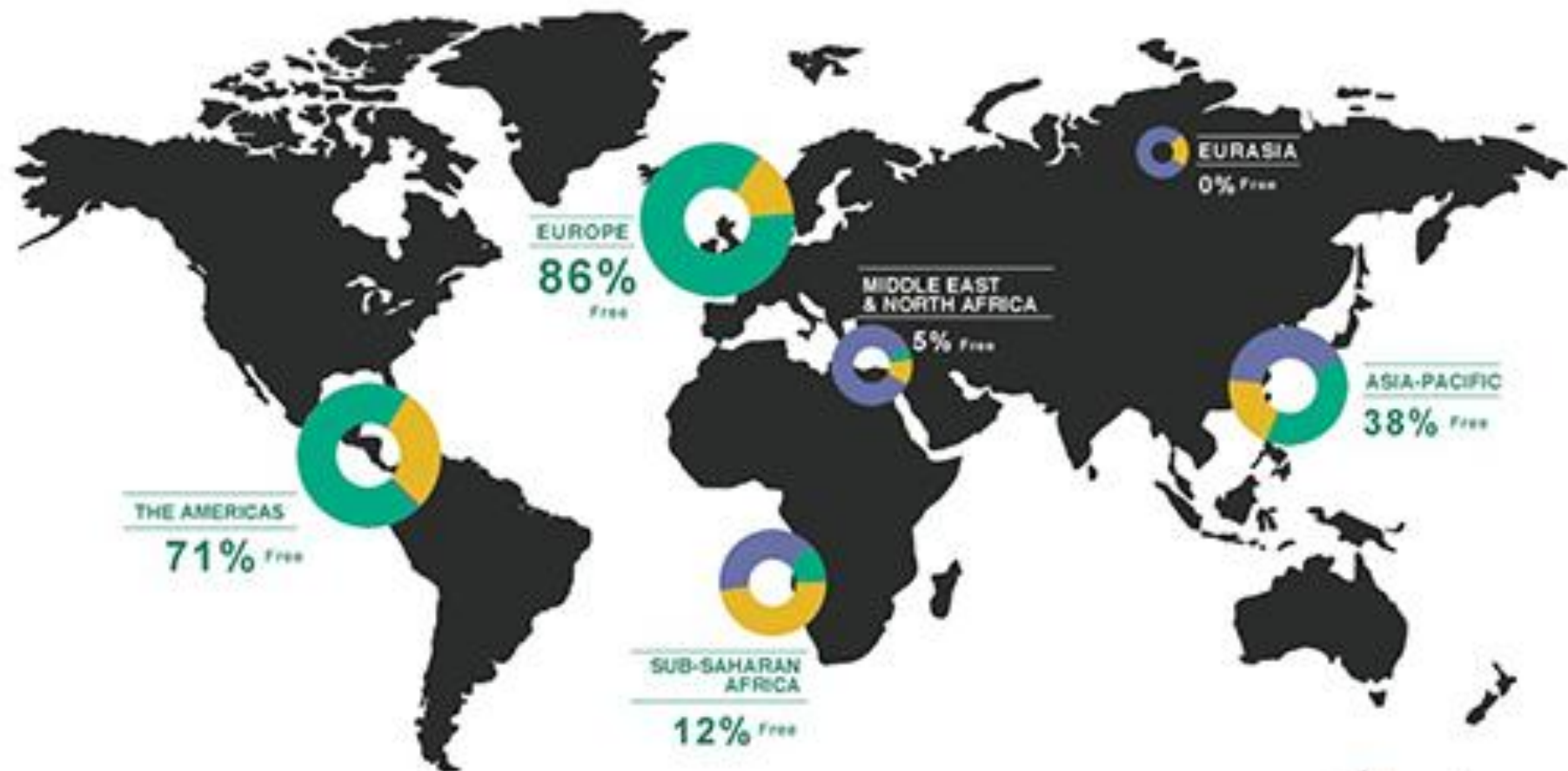

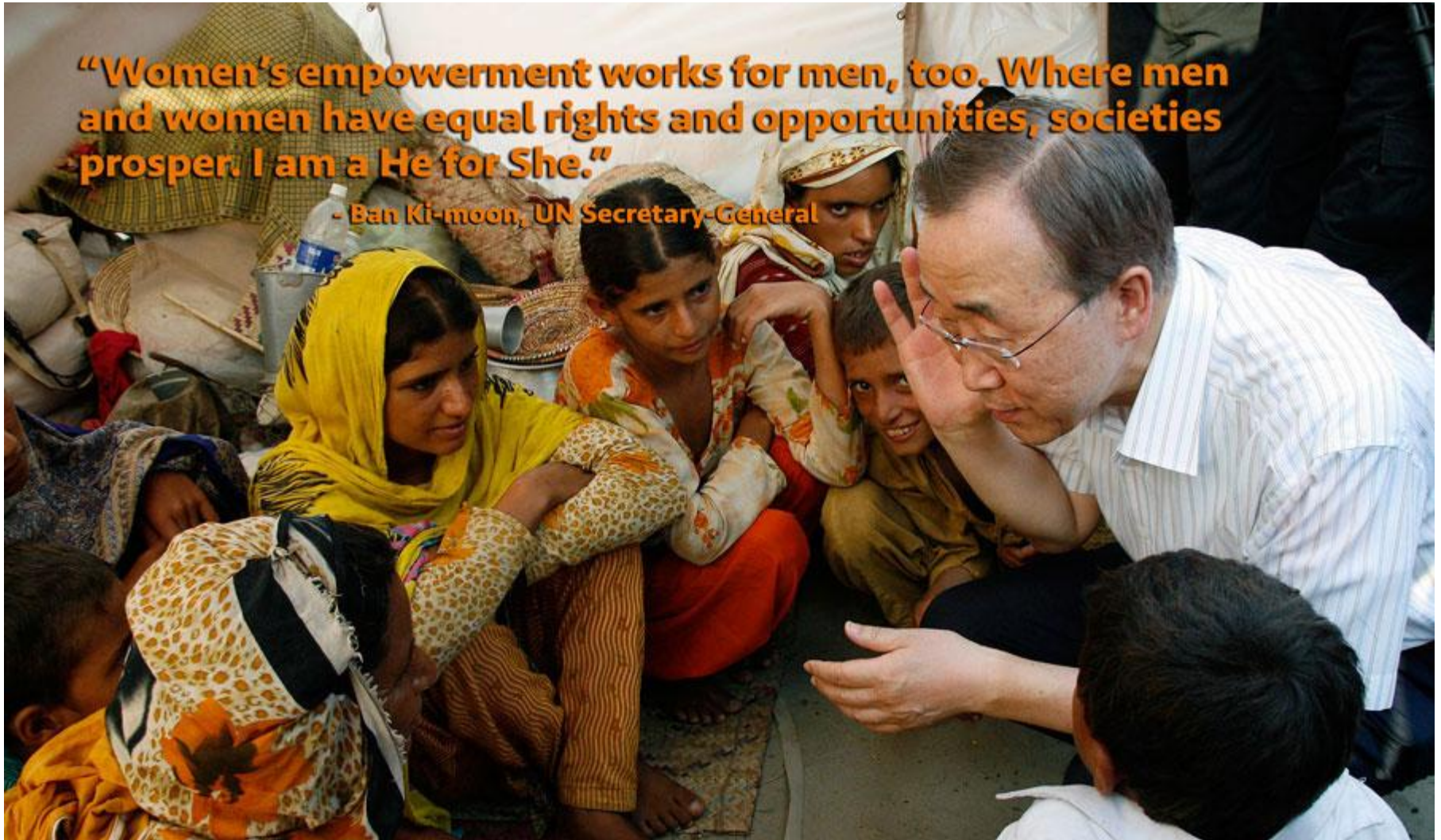


Conclusions:

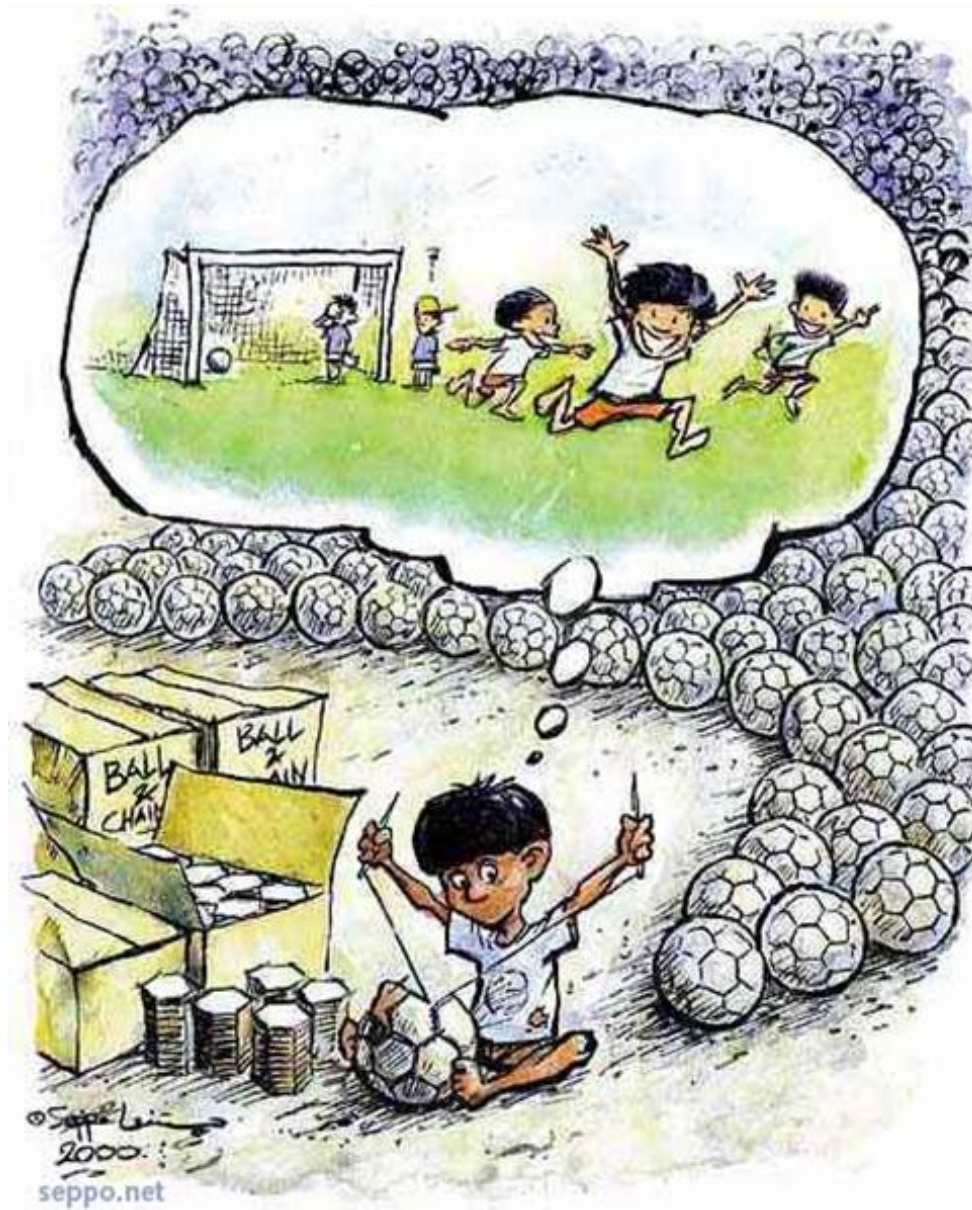
