Welcome from the RENATE Co-Presidents, Marie Power, HFB, & Ivonne van de Kar.

On behalf of the RENATE Network, we are pleased to present you with the 2024 Annual report.

It has been a year in which we once again achieved a lot together.

The RENATE Network is a large European community of members, active volunteers in the Task groups, country representatives on the RENATE Working Board & members of the Core group. Together, in Europe we form the religious network active in the fight against human trafficking & exploitation.

In 2024, the Law Task group achieved remarkable results following local research by RENATE members in 5 countries (Albania, Bulgaria, Romania, Spain & the United Kingdom). The law research was published 4 July 2024 with findings that much can still be improved for those working in the legal profession to support victims of human trafficking.

The Awareness-raising Task group accomplished its monumental task of providing information in schools in 28 of the 31 countries where RENATE is active. In two years, 6,000 students across Europe were informed about human trafficking & how to protect themselves. Another important RENATE project is the 'Empowerful Training,' in which survivors in shelters take a course to make them more resilient & increase their employment opportunities. This project was carried out in Albania & Greece.

In 2024, numerous webinars, training sessions & meetings were held. For example, a webinar about the consequences of war on the exploitation of women & children. The speakers came from Ukraine, Sudan & Kenya. A webinar was also held for the UN Women's Conference CSW68- on the importance of education & awareness-raising about human trafficking & exploitation.

After all, awareness-raising is one of the most important pillars of the RENATE network.

Ivonne van de Kar gave a talk at the European Parliament for MEPs & spoke about the importance of the role of religious & churches in the work against human trafficking. our work.

The work of the small INGO group active in Strasbourg should also be mentioned: they do important work.

In 2024, RENATE launched a short film about networking of religious against human trafficking in Europe & two more short films will be released in 2025. These can be found on the RENATE YouTube channel.

The mental health of volunteers & staff who carry out the work is very important to the RENATE network. For several years now, RENATE has offered them a spiritual retreat to stay grounded in the mission through consideration of relevant Bible verses & (time for) reflection. For that same reason, a training week was held for network members on trauma & mental health. Take good care of yourself too! Another important achievement this year was the meeting of RENATE members working in shelters across Europe. This resulted in the publication of a beautiful brochure in which the shelters introduce themselves & share best practices with each other. This is just a small selection of the many activities that the RENATE network & its member organisations organized in 2024. We ourselves are sometimes amazed at the wonderful & priceless work being done within this volunteer network.

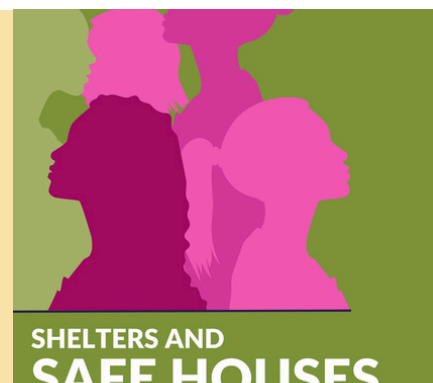

In order to bring attention to the issue of 'The effect/consequences of wars/war-situations on trafficking and exploitation - esp. for women and children, the RENATE Europe network held three morning events/webinars online, each of three hours duration, 14-16 May, 2024.

Thanks to the first-hand experiences of the presenters who work at grass-roots level in the UKRAINE; South Sudan and Kenya, participants were provided first-hand information about the realities of living and trying to function in areas of conflict, where traffickers ply their trade taking advantage of newly-vulnerable people.

WHO CARES FOR THE CARER?

Trauma & mental health of those working in the area of anti-human trafficking, is a recurring theme which this in-person training sought to address.

Empowering leadership is crucial for survivors of human trafficking, offering a beacon of hope and support in their journey to healing and rebuilding their lives..

It involves creating spaces for survivors to share their stories, access resources tailored to their unique needs and participate in decision-making processes that directly impact their lives.

In Albania & Greece, the programme consisted of six sessions over four days, between August & December 2024 and was designed to empower participants both personally and professionally; to enhance self-esteem, identify personal talents, and build concrete strategies for personal development.
